### Guidelines for 2011 CMAA ACADEMY OF COUNTRY MUSIC Scholarship

College applications are assessed on many elements, those listed below are to be used as a guide. The CMAA recommends students are between the ages of 18 and 35. Instrumentalists are also accepted and in 2011 are being encouraged to apply.

When applying you should consider the following:

**SKILLS:** Vocal skills, Guitar skills, Other instrument skills, and Songwriting skills (if applicable).

**EXPERIENCE:** Performance experience, Recording experience (not necessary).

**KNOWLEDGE:** Music theory knowledge, Industry knowledge.

**ATTITUDE:** Are you an independent confident person.

**COMMITMENT:** What are your plans for the future, What are your goals, How do you plan to achieve these goals.

**PERFORMANCE CONTENT:** Country music should clearly be your inspiration.

**PRESENTATION:** Speak comfortably to people, Present well on stage, Can make a connection with the audience, Grooming

To assist you further the following questions are a good guide to completing your application.

What do you expect to get out of the College experience?

What songwriters do you really like and why?

What does success in this industry mean to you?

Why should you be selected?

On a scale of 1 to 10 (with 10 being excellent) how would you rate your instrumental skills?

Same scale, how about your singing? (if applicable)

How many songs have you completed

Anything else we should know about you?
